20.601 Sec. 9401 **LICENSE.**

9401.1 No person shall conduct, maintain or operate any carnival, public show, circus or exhibition to which admission is obtained upon payment of money and which has no permanent location in the village without first obtaining a license as provided in this Chapter.

9401.2 The provisions of this Section shall not extend to any exhibitions by the pupils of any school or to any entertainment for the benefit of any school, church or for any benevolent or charitable object, and nothing contained herein shall be construed to require any school, church or those giving or responsible for any entertainment for any benevolent or charitable object to obtain a license hereunder. (code eff. Jan. 15, 1957)

20.602 Sec. 9402 APPLICATION FOR LICENSE.

9402.1 The Clerk shall require that any person desiring a license under this Article [20.600, Public Show, Circus or Exhibition] shall state in his application the proposed location of the business, the written consent of the owner of the property, the number of employees, **a** description of the sanitary facilities on the property, and a sufficient description of the type of show or exhibit to apprize the Clerk of its nature. (code eff. Jan. 15, 1957)

20.603 Sec. 9403 GRANTING OF LICENSE.

9403.1 The Clerk shall not grant such license except on certification of the Police and Fire Departments that all requirements prescribed by this Code have been complied with and that the public peace, health and safety are adequately safeguarded. (code eff. Jan. 15, 1957)

9403.2 The Clerk shall not grant such license if it shall appear that such show or exhibition is of an indecent or immoral nature. (code eff. Jan. 15, 1957)

20.604 Sec. 9404 **BOND.**

9404.1 The applicant, before being granted a license, shall file with the Clerk a bond, approved as to form by the Village Attorney, running to the village in the amount of \$1,000.00 which Bond shall become available in the payment of any damage to public or private property and the payment of any personal injuries resulting from the conducting, maintenance or operation of the business and shall be further conditioned that the applicant shall have the premises used by him in a clean and sanitary condition. (code eff. Jan. 15, 1957)
