Regular meeting of the Shepherd Village Council held on Tuesday, July 5, 2022. Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p by President DeGraw.

Pledge of Allegiance

Motion by Maloney, second by M. Davidson to approve minutes as amended of the meeting held on June 20, 202. Carried by roll call vote 5-0.

Purchase Requisitions: 1 requisition was presented from DPW for line painting from PK Contracting in the amount of \$3863.00. Motion by Coughlin, second by Maloney to approve the \$3863 to PK Contracting for line painting of Wright Avenue and parking. Carried by roll call vote 5-0.

Zoning Ordinance language/ZBA: discussion on section 1402, #6 to consider revising language. Planning Commission member, Shelly Davidson, will review more language from their meeting to present to council at the next meeting.

New Business:

Sidewalk chalk art: Clerk Gross was asked about a possible 4H group to come in and do a sidewalk chalk art event. More information is needed as type of chalk, event, number of people, etc. Clerk Gross will contact the interested individual for more information.

Historical Society Ice Cream Social event at the Veteran’s Memorial Park is scheduled for July 11, 2022.

Status on federal funding application for water project: still trying to obtain the new SAMS#. President DeGraw contacted Roger Hauck’s office who in turn had John Moolenaar’s office contact him and they are working on getting a solution for this delay.

Chief Sawyer informed Council that the Old 27 Car Tour is scheduled for August 25th and will be routed up Shepherd Rd from the south to east bound on Wright Avenue to the highway; the incident with the home invasion suspect was in jail in Gratiot County and now has been moved to Jackson after causing several other issues.
