**LIQUOR CONTROL; MINORS
VILLAGE OF SHEPHERD, MICHIGAN
ord. no. 6504 eff. Apr. 10, 1983**

An Ordinance to prohibit the sale of alcohol to minors, and to prohibit minors from possessing, transporting, or consuming alcohol in public places.

THE VILLAGE OF SHEPHERD, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Sec. 1. AGE, MISREPRESENTATION PROHIBITED.

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to falsely represent himself to be of the age of 21 years or over when purchasing, offering to purchase, or attempting to purchase or procure beer, wine or other alcoholic beverages, or to give any false information regarding his age to any law enforcement officer or to any other person selling beer, wine or other alcoholic beverages for the purpose of securing a sale thereof to himself.

Sec. 2. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; PROCURING FOR MINORS, PROHIBITION.

It shall be unlawful for any person to make any false representation in order to procure the sale or furnishing of beer, wine or other alcoholic beverages to any person under the age of 21 years.

Sec. 3. POSSESSION, TRANSPORTATION, ETC.; PROHIBITION, EXCEPTION.

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years of age to purchase or knowingly possess or transport any alcoholic liquor, or knowingly possess, transport or have under his or her control in any motor vehicle any beer, wine or other alcoholic liquor, unless such person is employed by a licensee under a license issued by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission and possesses, transports or has such alcoholic beverages under his control in a motor vehicle in the course of his employment during regular working hours.

Sec. 4. FURNISHING TO MINORS.

It shall be unlawful for any person to furnish alcoholic liquor to a minor person under the age of 21 years for any purpose except to an employee of a licensee under the Liquor Control Commission's rules and regulations in the regular course of employment and during working hours.

Sec. 5. CONSUMPTION, PUBLIC WAYS.

It shall be unlawful for any person to consume alcoholic liquor on the public highways, street and alleys, vehicle parking lots, or any public place within the Village where the consumption of alcoholic liquor is prohibited by the laws of the State.

Sec. 6. PENALTY.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00, or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days, or both. Any minor who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be dealt with by the juvenile division of the probate court or as prescribed by the laws of the State.
