**PARKING VIOLATIONS BUREAU
VILLAGE OF SHEPHERD, MICHIGAN
ord. no. 5129 eff. June 9, 1974**

An ordinance creating a Parking Violations Bureau in the Village of Shepherd.

THE VILLAGE OF SHEPHERD ORDAINS:

Sec. 1. BUREAU ESTABLISHED.

Pursuant to provisions of Act 154 Public Acts 1968, a Parking Violations Bureau, for the purpose of handling pleas of guilty in parking violation cases, and to collect the fines and costs as prescribed in the Village of Shepherd Parking Ordinance, is hereby established. The Parking Violations Bureau shall be under the supervision and control of the Chief of Police. (ord. no. 5129 eff. June 9, 1974)

Sec. 2. LOCATION.

The Chief of Police shall, subject to the approval of the Village Council, establish a convenient location for the Parking Violations Bureau and appoint a qualified person to administer the same, and adopt rules and regulations for the operation thereof. (ord. no. 5129 eff. June 9, 1974)

Sec. 3. VIOLATIONS.

The Parking Violations Bureau shall assess the fines prescribed in Ordinance No. 20.070 Chapter 5, Article I for the violations scheduled therein. (ord. no. 5129 eff. June 9, 1974)

Sec. 4. PROCEEDS.

All proceeds from the operation of the Parking Violations Bureau shall be delivered to the Village Treasurer at such times as directed by the Village Council. (ord. no. 5129 eff. June 9, 1974)

Sec. 5. SEPARABILITY.

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof. (ord. no. 5129 eff. June 9, 1974)

Sec. 6. ORDINANCES REPEALED.

All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed. (ord. no. 5129 eff. June 9, 1974)

Sec. 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force 20 days after its enactment as provided by the statutes of the State of Michigan.
