**PARKING VIOLATIONS; FINES AND PENALTIES
VILLAGE OF SHEPHERD, MICHIGAN

An Ordinance to establish fines and penalties for violations of the Sections of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages adopted by Chapter V, Article IV, of the Ordinances of the Village of Shepherd pertaining to the parking of motor vehicles.

THE VILLAGE OF SHEPHERD ORDAINS:

Sec. 1. VIOLATIONS OF SEC. 8.10(c).

The fine for violations of the following Sections of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages as adopted by Chapter V, Article IV, of the Ordinances of the Village of Shepherd shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) if disposed of at the Parking Violations Bureau of the Village within ten (10) days after the issuance of a traffic ticket or notice of violation.

Sec. 2. VIOLATIONS OF SECS. 8.1 AND 8.2.

The fine for violations of the following Sections of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages as adopted by Chapter V, Article IV, of the Ordinances of the Village of Shepherd shall be Two Dollars (\$2.00) if disposed of at the Parking Violations Bureau of the Village within ten (10) days after the issuance of a traffic ticket or notice of violation.

SECTIONS 8.1 AND 8.2

Sec. 3. VIOLATIONS OF ALL OTHER SECTIONS.

The fine for violations of all other Sections, except the Sections mentioned above, of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages as adopted by Chapter V, Article IV, of the Ordinances of the Village of Shepherd shall be Three Dollars (\$3.00) if disposed of at the Parking Violations Bureau of the Village within ten (10) days after the issuance of a traffic ticket or notice of violation.

Sec. 4. ORDINANCES REPEALED.
