Sec. 9501 **POSTING SIGNS AND NOTICES PROHIBITED.**

9501.1 Hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person to post any placards, signs, **notices or** other advertising material on any telephone pole, light pole or tree within the corporate limits of the Village of Shepherd. It shall likewise be unlawful to post any such signs, placards **or other** advertising material on any private property without the consent of the owner.

**ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 20.401 OF THE COMPLES ORDINANCES
OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEPHERD
(DISORDERLY CONDUCT ORDINANCE)**

That Ordinance 20.401 (Disorderly Conduct) be amended to add the following new Sections:

A person shall be deemed guilty of disorderly conduct if that person is any of the following:

- M. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any noisy riotous persons to assemble in any house owned, occupied or controlled by him/her, to the annoyance and or disturbance of the neighborhood and the public peace.
- N. It shall be unlawful for any person to act or encourage another person to act in a violent, boisterous, turbulent, quarrelsome, indecent, or disorderly manner, or commit any act, or to do anything to disturb the good order, or peace and dignity of the Village of Shepherd, its inhabitants or other persons.

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption:

Sec. 9502 **LEGAL NOTICES AND POLITICAL ADVERTISEMENTS EXEMPTED.**

9502.1 Provided that this Article [20.300, Signs and Notices; Posting] shall not be construed to prohibit the posting of legal notices, election notices, and such political advertisements as may be used by qualified candidates in any federal, state, county, township or village election, which materials are hereby specifically exempted from the operation of this Article.
