THE VILLAGE OF SHEPHERD ORDAINS:

Sec. 1. AUTHORIZATION TO DIRECT TRAFFIC: 20.151 SCHOOL PROPERTY; EMERGENCIES.

"SECTION 5103.1 Members of the police department of the Village of Shepherd and of the law enforcement agencies of Isabella County and the State of Michigan are hereby authorized to direct all traffic in conformance with the provisions of this Code and the provisions of the Motor Vehicle Code of the State of Michigan, such authorization to "tend to the enforcement of said Code with regard to traffic, but vehicular and pedestrian, on such property within or adjacent to the Village of Shepherd as owned, occupied, possessed or used by the Shepherd Public Schools, provided, that in the event of a fire or other emergencies, or to expedite traffic, or to safeguard pedestrians, they may direct traffic as conditions may require, notwithstanding the provisions of this Code."
